RIESLING

Riesling thrives on the bright days, cool nights and long, dry autumns found in New Zealand's South Island.

With its fruit intensity, citrus notes and refreshing acidity, it lends its self to a whole range of food matches.

ROSE

Most winemakers that produce Pinot Noir will also produce a Rose style wine. NZ Rose is made to drink immediately rather than age, resulting in crisp, fresh and fruit forward flavours.

Rose was traditionally drunk in the summer, however NZ has been enjoying this varietal all year long.

SWEET WINE

Sweet wines (often called dessert wines) are produced in either of two ways. Botrytis and Late Harvest.

Botrytis is a beneficial mould that grows on ripe wine grapes in the vineyard under specific climatic controls. Wines made from these berries have a rich, complex and honeyed character and often high in residual sugar.

Late harvest is as the name suggest. Grapes are left on the vine for longer to naturally dehydrate to concentrate the grape. Grapes are left with a high residual sugar in their juices.

They possess some of the best kept vineyard in the district and have grown quality fruit from their old, low yielding vines for six successive generations.</p> <p>Young gun Barossa winemaker Kym Teusner undoubtedly makes some of the finest wines in the Barossa Valley today. There's a vibrancy and excitement to his wines that continues to win hearts and minds aplenty. His Riebke Shiraz has proven to be a bona fide star in recent years and his latest release will surely have you coming back for more! With its rich, full-bodied palate that Barossa Shiraz lovers can't get enough of, the Riebke is also balanced with fine, powdery tannin and great use of oak to bring a moreish quality to this great value-for-money Shiraz.</p>	100

INTERNATIONAL SELECTION

Below we have a selection of International wines, selected from vineyards in Spain, France and Italy. The wines have been picked due to their fantastic pairing with food, complexity vineyard and winemaker history.

SPAIN

Muriel Blanco 2017 (White) BOTTLE 44.5

Made from 100% Viura grapes, also known as Macabeo, this wine is crafted by a well respected winery in the Rioja town of Elciego. Est. 1926.

Intense aromas with a floral and fruity reminiscence, such as green apples and citrus fruits. The flavours are well expressed as fullness on the palate. Balanced acidity, with a pleasant and persistent finish. Matches well with all kinds of seafood, salads and light dishes

Muriel Crianza 2015 (Red) 42.5

100% Tempranillo aged in American oak for 1 year and aged for a further 12 month in bottle before release
The aroma of fine aging (vanilla, coconut, roasted coffee) is combined with notes of ripe red berries and liquorice. The palate is wide and elegant, with a clean aftertaste. Matches well with appetizers, all kinds of tapas, chicken, lamb, beef, game and mildly cured cheeses

FRANCE

Dourthe No.1 Bordeaux Rouge 2015 59.5

Created by the Theinot family, with 177 years of winemaking history they are one of the best and most successful wine producers in Bordeaux. High quality grapes are selected for this blend - 65% Merlot and 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, with 12 months aging in French oak.
Full bodied, chocolaty, round and soft with lovely fruit expression

ITALY

Poggio Nchiaia Filetto DCG Chianti Superiore 2016 (100% Sangiovese) 56

Reminiscent of red fruits, such as blackberry, strawberry and raspberry. Rounded, soft body with dry, full, fruity finish. The Chianti lends itself to game and mature cheeses. And is at its best with rich dishes where the wine's acidity

PINOT NOIR

Pinot Noir is predominantly grown in the cooler climates of the South Island. Central Otago is home to some of the best Pinot Noir in the world with its seasonal temperature variations caused by the surrounding mountain ranges.

Waipara is also home to an array of award winning Pinot Noir with its warm days and cold nights.

Pegasus Bay (Waipara) 2013		95
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Perfect growing season meant this year meant optimal ripeness of grapes at picking. Raspberry, pomegranate, cherry, chocolate and spice come to forefront of this wine. Rich in texture and mouth filling with powerful but velvety tannins. Long finish. If you're after a power packed Pinot, this is the one!

Grayling (Waipara) 2017	9	45.5
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Light, oaky pinot with hints of dark cherries and smoke

Madam Sass (Central Otago) 2018		74.5
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This enticing Pinot Noir is full of attitude, style and extravagance. Decadent blackberry and sweet dark cherry aromas are delivered with opulence, chalky tannins and complex oak spice.

SHIRAZ

Barossa Valley, South Australia is a renowned growing region for this varietal and has some of the oldest Shiraz vines in the world. Its series of transverse valleys and sloping hills create a wide range of microclimates suitable for making world class wine.

Taste of plum, boysenberry and raspberry, alongside more savoury characters of black olive and dark chocolate. An easy drinking Shiraz

Yalumba (Barossa Valley, AU) 2017	11.5	51.5
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A powerful Shiraz with notes of dark fruits, spice and hints of licorice with a slightly oaky overtone

Mount Langi "Billi Billi" 2016 (Victoria, AU)	12.5	57
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Bright red berry fruits laced with spices of clove and pepper. Fine tannins for this medium bodied Shiraz

Rockford "Basket Press" (Barossa Valley) 2011	168
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Made at the Barossa winery that embraces traditional winemaking techniques and equipment. The resulting wine is a very special bold Shiraz. Notes of Blackcurrant, blueberries and ripe fruit with a hint of smoked cinnamon.

Best consumed after aeration- please see your waiter to organise this wine to be poured into a decanter

Fromm Syrah (Marlborough, NZ) 2017	95
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Fromm has the philosophy of terroir over technology and grape quality over quantity. Their wines have an uncompromising emphasis on texture and drinkability

Their Syrah (Shiraz) is mostly made up of grapes from 27 year old vines, meaning complexity and depth follows through. Concentrated red fruit with spice and pepper for the kick and with a fruity long finish

Best consumed after aeration- please see your waiter to organise this wine to be poured into a decanter

BLENDED REDS

Blending makes wine more complex. It is used to maximize the expression of a wine and can enhance aromas, colours, textures, body and finish.

Often, different grape varietals will have great synergy when blended with one another making some very bold, structured and complex wines.

Church Road "McDonald Series" Merlot (Hawkes Bay) 2015	10	47

Celebrating the late Tom McDonald, a pioneer in elevating quality winemaking in Hawkes Bay that all vineyards benefit from today

This Merlot is fruit forward, with dark berries and plums complimented by aromas of roses, cedar and warm spice. Slightly oaky with a fine tannin finish

Main Divide Merlot Cabernet (Waipara) 2017	11.5	52.5
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Aromas of dark fruit, blackberries and boysenberries layered with hints of liquorice, cloves and spice. Full bodied wine with soft tannins

Angus the Bull Cabernet Sauvignon (Victoria, AU) 2016	10.5	49
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Powerful wine with big flavours of dark fruit and spice with an underlying vanilla spice. This wine is exceptional with red meat

Esk Valley "Gimblet Gravels" Merlot/Cabernet/Malbec (Hawkes Bay) 2017	45.5
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Medium bodied blend with notes of strong dark fruit and spices, soft finish with mild tannins. Another great food wine
