Try the Okinawan hand crafts such as bingata, pottery and glassware which will enhance your trip on this beautiful island.

Coral/bingata dyeing

Experience coral dyeing using coral fossils, or Bingata dyeing which is a traditional stenciling method passed on from the Ryukyu Dynasty era. This distinct beautiful and colorful dye is a traditional and unique method to Okinawa.
Duration: Approximately 1 hour



Ryukyu Glass

One of the unique features of a Ryukyu glass is that they are handmade with simplicity and warmth. Please experience it as a personal memory of your trip.
Duration: Approximately 10 minutes



Tsuboya Pottery

A pottery that has a simple and warm quality. Let's try making a one of a kind Shisa or plates.
Duration: 1 to 1.5 hours



Shuri Textile

Shuri-ori, the textile was a formal and high quality woven fabric which was only allowed to be worn by the royalty, aristocrats, and samurai during the Ryukyu Dynasty. Experience weaving this colorful fabric.
